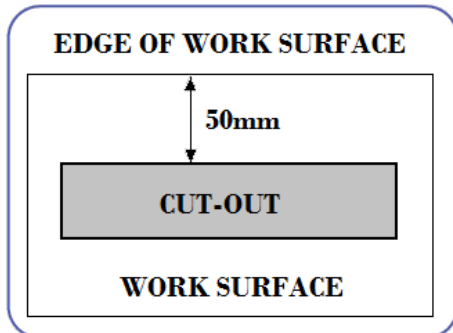

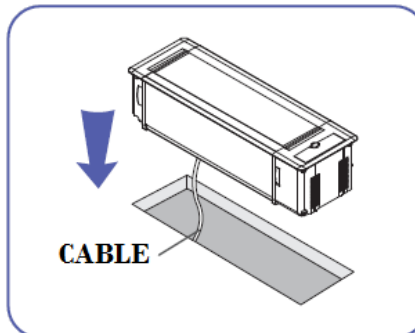
INSTALLATION & OPERATION

INSTALLATION



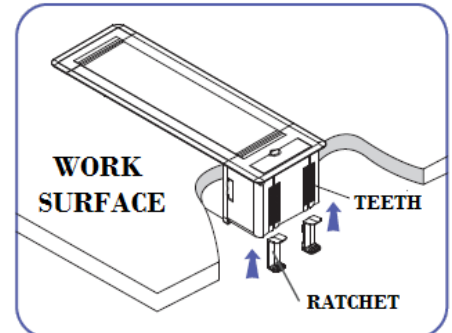
STEP 1

Measure the Rotadock Length (determined by configuration) and make a cut-out in a predetermined location with the measured length and the standard width on 115mm. Ensure there is sufficient clearance: 50mm from the edge of the cut-out to the edge of the mounted surface and at least 100mm below the work surface. Ensure that the cable has enough slack in both open and closed positions.



STEP 2

Lower the unit cable first into the cut-out. Do not connect the unit to power until the installation is complete.



STEP 3

Line-up the ratchet with the side of the Rotadock unit so that the teeth on both the ratchet and the unit are facing each other. Slide the ratchet on from below.

If the ratchet is correctly engaged, the teeth will make a clicking sound as they slide over each other. If not, pull back on the ratchet clip until the teeth disengage and the ratchet can be slid off with ease.

Width: 115mm (approx. 4 - 1/2 in.)
 Length: Depending on configuration
 Height (Open): 107mm (Aprox. 4 - 1/5 in.)

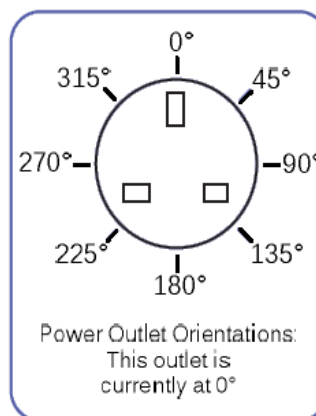

Operating Voltage: 220V - 250V @ 50Hz
 110V - 125V AC @ 60Hz
 Current: 15A

MAINTENANCE AND CARE:

- o Ensure unit is disconnected prior to cleaning.
- o Clean the unit with a damp cloth and dry immediately.
- o Do not use harsh chemical solvents
